On January 26 and February 7, 1994, Anthony Kirkwood of this office conducted a routine safety inspection at 330 Roberts Street, East Hartford, Connecticut and on Myrtle Street at Interstate 95, in Stamford, Connecticut of activities authorized by the above listed NRC license. The inspection was an examination of your licensed activities as they relate to radiation safety and to compliance with the Commission's regulations and the license conditions. The inspection consisted of observations by the inspector, interviews with personnel, and a selective examination of representative records. The findings of the inspection were discussed with James Plagianos, Resident Engineer, of your staff, at the conclusion of the inspection. This also refers to the telephone conversations on January 31 and February 2, 1994 between you and Anthony Kirkwood.

From the discussions of our findings at the conclusion of the inspection, we understand that you will not use your licensed material until you have submitted an amendment to your license. The amendment will include: (1) changing the mailing address to a permanent location; (2) listing all field sites of greater than 180 days duration, i.e., Stamford, Connecticut as of May 21, 1994; and (3) changing the Radiation Safety Officer listed on your license to someone who can supervise the daily safety activities required by NRC. We request that you submit your request for a license amendment within 30 days of the date of this letter. In addition, we request that within 30 days, you describe all actions taken or planned with respect to the above three items so that your radiation safety program remains in compliance with NRC regulations.

Within the scope of this inspection, no violations were identified.
