SUMMARY

J. Stauter called to discuss draft license condition B.1, which would require KM to stop excavation work until a soil sorting procedure was approved by NRC. I called J. Stauter 2/4/93 @ ~ 1800 to discuss this issue, and the draft license in general, as well as to check the status of the revised decommissioning handling plan, which KM had verbally agreed to submit during a call to Ed Still on 1/25/93. The 2/5/93 call was a continuation of the ^{one} 2/4/93 call. J. Stauter is concerned that to stop work would cost KM considerably and assured me that the sorting procedure was conservative, and that significant mixing of greater than BTP Optia 2 material with less than BTP Optia 2 material was not occurring. J. Stauter recommends that NRC agree to accept a submittal of methods to sorting prior to placing material in Temporary Storage Areas, which would allow KM to continue excavating material. I informed Mr. Stauter that
