We recognize that you have discovered only a small amount of Thermo-Lag in Unit 1, and that you have satisfied yourself that the matter has been resolved within DLC. However, NRC has not completed its review of the Thermo-Lag issue, and a response to our letter is required addressing the use of Thermo-Lag in Unit 1.
