If this report contains any information that you (or your contractor) believe to be confidential, it is necessary that you take a written application within 30 days to this office to withdraw such information from public disclosure. Any such application must include a full statement of the reasons on the basis of which it is claimed that the information is proprietary, and should be premised on that you do not disclose information in a publication or otherwise in a way that would compromise your interests. If it is not your desire to withdraw this information in the specified period, the report will be placed in the Public Document Room.

It is our understanding that the vendor will take the following corrective action:

1. The M. W. Kellogg, Specification No. S416 will be revised to conform with the random radiography requirements of ANSI-B31.7, Nuclear Power Piping Code.
2. The responsible M.W. Kellogg management personnel will sign any shop traveler operations that have been deleted or revised subsequent to their issuance.

We will review these corrective actions during subsequent inspections.
