Gentlemen:

Pursuant to the enclosed Initial Decision dated October 5, 1978, of the Commission's Atomic Safety and Licensing Board, we have issued the enclosed Amendment No. 34 to Facility Operating License No. NPF-1 for the Trojan Nuclear Plant.

The amendment consists of changes to the license and appended Technical Specifications that permit modification of the spent fuel pool which will increase the storage capacity from 280 to 651 fuel elements. The amendment is in response to your application dated January 6, 1977, as supplemented and amended April 26, August 29, September 27, October 4 and 10, November 8 and 10, December 15 and 21, 1977 and January 18, 1978 and incorporates the three conditions ordered by the Board in its Initial Decision of October 5, 1978.

A copy of the related Notice of Issuance and Negative Declaration which is being filed with the Office of the Federal Register for publication is also enclosed. Copies of our Safety Evaluation and Environmental Impact Appraisal related to this action were sent to you by our letter dated November 11, 1977.
