## NOTICE OF VIOLATION

Wisconsin Public Service Company

Docket No. 50-305

As a result of the inspection conducted on October 18-22, 1982, and in accordance with the NRC Enforcement Policy, 47 FR 9987 (March 9, 1982), the following violation was identified:

10 CFR 20.203(f) requires that each container of licensed material bear a durable, clearly visible label identifying the radioactive contents.

Contrary to the above, numerous plastic bags and steel drums containing radioactive materials did not bear radioactive materials caution labels. One such container had a radiation level of 35 mrem/hour on contact.

This is a Severity Level V violation (Supplement IV).

Pursuant to the provisions of 10 CFR 2.201, you are required to submit to this office within thirty days of the date of this Notice a written statement or explanation in reply, including for each item of noncompliance: (1) corrective action taken and the results achieved; (2) corrective action to be taken to avoid further noncompliance; and (3) the date when full compliance will be achieved. Consideration may be given to extending your response time for good cause shown.
