Walton, and P. Prescott of this office from December 26, 1993, through February 7, 1994. This inspection included a review of authorized activities for your Quad Cities Nuclear Power Station facility. At the conclusion of the inspection, the findings were discussed with those members of your staff identified in the enclosed report. Areas examined during the inspection are identified in the report. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of a selective examination of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observation of activities in progress. During this inspection, certain of your activities appeared to be in violation of NRC requirements, as specified in the enclosed Notice of Violation (Notice). This violation is of concern because of continued personnel performance failures regarding procedural adherence. In addition to the noted violation, weaknesses in operation's management oversight, discussed in paragraph 5 of the enclosed report, appear to have contributed to recent events. You are required to respond to this letter and should follow the instructions specified in the enclosed Notice when preparing your response. In your response, you should document the specific actions taken and any additional actions you plan to prevent recurrence. After reviewing your response to this Notice, including your proposed corrective actions and the results of future inspections, the NRC will determine whether further NRC enforcement action is necessary to ensure compliance with NRC regulatory requirements.
