Dear Mr. Combs:

This refers to the routine safety inspection conducted by Mr. D. R. Gibbons of this office on February 16, 1994, of activities authorized by NRC Byproduct Material License No. 48-17480-01, and to the discussion of our findings with you and Mr. Terry Wallander at the conclusion of the inspection.

The inspection was an examination of activities conducted under your license as they relate to radiation safety and to compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations and with the conditions of your license. The inspection consisted of a selective examination of procedures and representative records, observations, independent measurements, and interviews with personnel.

In addition to the above areas, the inspector examined actions described in your letter dated December 9, 1992, regarding violations found during our September 28, 30 and October 2, 1992 inspection. We have no further questions regarding these matters.

During this inspection, certain of your activities were found to be in violation of NRC requirements, as specified in the enclosed Notice. A written response is required.

An additional violation was also identified for failure to record the kinds of byproduct material on your quarterly inventory records as required by 10 CFR 34.26. However, since this violation is categorized as a Severity Level V violation and you corrected the violation prior to our inspection, we are exercising discretion pursuant to Appendix C, Section VII.B. of the NRC's Enforcement Policy specified in 10 CFR Part 2 and have not included this item in the Notice of Violation.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.790 of the Commission's regulations, a copy of this letter, the enclosure, and your response to this letter will be placed in the NRC Public Document Room.

The response directed by this letter and the accompanying Notice are not subject to the clearance procedures of the Office of Management and Budget as required by the Paperwork Reduction Act of 1980, PL 96-511.
