Gentlemen:

This refers to the inspection conducted by Mr. M. S. Kidd of this office on July 31 - September 1, 1978, of activities authorized by NRC License No. NPF-4 and Construction Permit No. CPPR-78 for the North Anna Power Station, Unit 1 and 2 facilities, and to the discussion of our findings held with Mr. W. R. Cartwright and others of your staff periodically during the inspection.

Areas examined during the inspection and our findings are discussed in the enclosed inspection report. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observations by the inspector.

We have examined actions you have taken with regard to previously identified inspection findings. These are discussed in the enclosed inspection report.

One new unresolved item resulted from this inspection and is discussed in the enclosed report. This item will be examine during subsequent inspections.

During the inspection it was found that certain activities under your license appear to be in noncompliance with NRC requirements. This item and references to pertinent requirements are listed in the Notice of Violation enclosed herewith as Appendix A. Corrective actions to prevent recurrence were completed prior to the conclusion of this inspection; therefore, a reply is not requested.

In accordance with Section 2.790 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice," Part 2, Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations, a copy of this letter and the enclosed inspection report will be placed in the NRC's Public Document Room. If this report contains any information that you (or your contractor) believe to be proprietary, it is necessary that you make a written application within 20 days to this office to withhold such information from public disclosure. Any such application must include a full statement of
