Subject: Inspection No. 50-322/82-34

This refers to the team inspection conducted by representatives of this office on November 29 - December 3; December 6 - 10 and 13 - 15, 1982, at Shoreham Nuclear Power Station and your Hicksville and Melville, New York, Corporate Offices of activities authorized by NRC License No. CPPR-95; activities relating to your application for an NRC operating license; and, to the discussions of our findings held by Mr. D. L. Capton of my staff with Mr. J. W. Dye, Senior Vice President, you, and other members of your staff at the conclusion of the inspection on December 15, 1982.

Areas examined during this inspection are described in the NRC Region I Inspection Report which is enclosed with this letter. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observations by the inspector.

Within the scope of this inspection, no violations were observed.

This inspection was performed as part of an NRC routine inspection program to determine the status of your Quality Assurance program for operations of the Shoreham facility. Based on this inspection, we find numerous items that must be addressed and appropriately corrected by LILCO before additional required NRC inspection can be initiated. These items are identified in the attached report as requiring action before operating license (OL) issuance. In addition, we note that licensee representatives have disputed several inspection findings. Accordingly, within thirty (30) days of the date of this letter, please provide a letter to us describing your position on each unresolved OL issue, the basis for dispute of our findings where appropriate, planned corrective actions and the date by which these actions will be completed. Following receipt of your letter, a meeting will be scheduled between our staffs to insure agreement on the path to resolution of these issues.

An advance copy of the enclosed inspection report was provided to you solely for proprietary review in accordance with 10 CFR 2.790 on December 30, 1982. On January 3, 1982, Mr. John P. Morin of your staff stated in a telephone conversation that the report contained no proprietary information. Accordingly, a copy of this letter and the enclosure is being placed in the NRC's Public Document Room.
