On December 29, 1982 at 9:34 p.m., PST, the General Construction Security Office at Diablo Canyon received a telephone call from a male caller. The caller stated: "This is no joke. There is a bomb in Containment I due to go of at midnight".

As a precautionary measure, the licensee evacuated Unit I Containment. A search of Containment by site Operations Security Personnel met with negative results.

Licensee notified San Luis Obispo County Sheriff Office (LLEA), and NRC Headquarters Duty Officer. LLEA notified FBI (Santa Maria, CA).

No press release is planned by the licensee or Region V.

The IAT was initially notified by HQ Duty Officer, and again by Region V at 9:40 a.m. PST, December 30, 1982.
