SUMMARY

Scope:

CLEAR REQULATO

This routine, announced inspection was conducted in the areas of the Physical Security Program for Power Reactors. Specifically, the areas evaluated were: Management Support; Protected and Vital Area Barriers; Protected Area Access Control; Alarm Stations; Power Supply; and Security Training.

Results:

In the areas inspected, violations or deviations were not identified. Violation 93-12-01 (Inadequate illumination of laydown yard within Protected Area) was closed. The licensee's corrective action and continued assessment was deemed adequate. (See Paragraph 2, Report Details).

The licensee's security program was determined to be effective in providing an acceptable level of protection for the nuclear station's resources and the design basis threat of radiological sabotage. The performance of the security force was reflected in their professionalism in carrying out their operational duties. Of noteworthy mention is the proficiency displayed by the security force during their implementation of their contingency response following an early morning reactor trip on February 2, 1994.

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
