Dear Mr. Berggren:

As the result of a series of meetings between representatives of the United States Marine Corps, United States Marshals Service and Southern California Edison Company, it would now appear that, pursuant to 10 CFR 73.55 (h)(1), applicants have established a liaison with appropriate law enforcement authorities having jurisdiction over the San Onofre site.

Applicants will rely primarily on the Southern California Edison Company security forces at San Onofre to contain any criminal activity or acts of industrial sabotage. In the event the San Onofre security force is unable to contain or repel the illegal activity, it will call for aid from the United States Marshals Service and the United States Marine Corps. That those entities will respond to a request for assistance is reflected in the attached letter of August 14, 1978, from R. C. McDonald, Colonel, U. S. Marine Corps, to Mr. Joe T. Head, Jr., of Southern California Edison Company, and letter of November 6, 1978, from David R. Pigott to Mr. James R. Laffoon, United States Marshal, Southern District of California.
