Gentlemen:

Thank you for your letter of December 1, 1982, containing Consumer's Power Company response to the two violations identified in our letter of October 28, 1982. We will review the corrective actions during a future inspection.

As to withdrawal of the second citation, we decline on the basis that two separate requirements of the Technical Specifications were involved: the first a requirement to perform a specific surveillance and the second, a requirement to notify the NRC when the program is not done as described. It is consistent with our policy that each merits a citation. On occasion, a single citation will be written to cover more than one example of violation of a single generic requirement such as a requirement to follow procedures.
