Subject: VICE PRESIDENT OF NUCLEAR OPERATIONS RESIGNS

B. Ralph Sylvia, Vice President of Nuclear Operations for Cincinnati Gas and Electric Company, has announced his resignation, effective January 14, 1983. He will be employed by the Atlantic Group, a Norfolk, VA., consulting firm.

He started at the utility in September 1981 with responsibilities for startup activities at the Zimmer station.

Mr. Sylvia has not publicly discussed his reasons for leaving the utility. Region III (Chicago) intends to contact him regarding the circumstances of his resignation.

The resignation has been reported by the Cincinnati area news media.

Region III (Chicago) learned of the pending resignation on January 4, 1983. This information is current as of 9 a.m. (CST), January 6, 1983.

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
