## Gentlemen:

For your application dated September 25, 1978 (TS 118), requesting amendment to Facility License No. DPR-52 for Browns Ferry Unit No. 2, you transmitted by wire a fee of \$400 for a Class I action. You considered the September 25 application to be a duplicate of a portion of your August 3, 1978 TS Change Request 113 for Browns Ferry Unit No. 3. To qualify as a duplicate in fee Class I for a second essentially identical unit at the same site, the application for the amendment for each unit must be received, processed and issued at the same time. Since your September 25 application was received at a different time and will be processed and issued separately, it does not qualify as a duplicate of your August 3 application.

We have determined from our preliminary review that your September 25 application falls in Class III (\$4,000) because it involves consideration of a single safety issue. Therefore, you should forward the balance due of \$3,600 for the Class III fee promptly to this office. If after the final review of your application is completed it is determined that it was incorrectly classified, you will be refunded any overpayment or billed for any additional amount due.
