Subject: PROPOSED RULE, PTS 19 AND 20

Al Roecklein,

I have reviewed your proposed rule in detail and concluded that we can go without resubmittal to OMB because currently we have approval for two versions of the regulations, the one previously on the books and the one scheduled to go into effect 1-94. Therefore, the reporting requirement in question is approved under both rules, but as of 1-94 approval for the copy to be sent to the individual would no longer be covered. Because I agree that this is simply accounting for the additional copy to the individual, we will annotate our file to incorporate this requirement during the next review cycle.

Please note that there is a need to change the Paperwork Reduction Act Statement as follows:

"This proposed rule does not contain a new or amended information collection requirement subject to the Paperwork Reduction Act of 1980 (44 U.S.C. 3501 et seq.). Existing requirements were approved by the Office of Management and Budget, approval numbers 3150-0044, 3150-0014, 3150-0005, and 3150-0006."

Please note that I included the approval number for Part 19 and also made some cosmetic changes for consistency with our standard statements. Please ensure that you make this change so that when ADM sends us a copy for review we won't have to place the rule on hold.
