A belated thanks for the time we spent chatting at Von's in Via Verde several weeks ago.

As I explained at that time, with my daughter, Jessica, at my side, I appreciated your support when we were competing for the contract to supply the microfilm cabinets for the Census Bureau.

We were fortunate to receive not only the Census award, but also many other prestigious installations, including most recently all of the microfilm cabinets for the new National Archives and Records Administration building in College Park, MD., and the new Los Angeles Central Library.

There is a new project we are working on that I wanted to make you aware of. In 1987 we supplied all of the "universal media" cabinets (accommodating a variety of media) for the Nuclear Regulatory Agency for their first building in Rockville, MD.
