Connecticut Yankee Atomic Power Company hereby submits the draft Exercise Controllers' Manual (scenario package) for NRC Staff review for this year's on-site emergency preparedness full-participation exercise at the Haddam Neck Plant scheduled for May 14, 1994. This date was previously discussed with the NRC Region I Staff.

Since this information may change based upon NRC Staff comments and further internal review, final Exercise Controllers' Manuals will be provided to the NRC Staff at the NRC entrance meeting.


