Dear Dr. Sreniawski:

I am writing you regarding certain errors in your inspection summary accompanying your notice of violation dated 4/28/81 all accompanying your letter to EMU President John Porter of April 29, 1981 in connection with the above referenced licensee and licenses.

Please refer to your Inspection Summary concerning your inspection of licensee's premises on January 14 and 15, 1981, and signed on 4/28/81 by C.T.Oberg, E.R.Matson, and D.J.Sreniawski. The following errors and changes should be noted in your records:

"DETAILS"

Page 2, Item 1: "Persons Contacted"

- ** "Jack Spike" is incorrect. The true name is Clark G. Spike.
- ** Gary VanGenderen was not a graduate student at the time of the inspection, but rather a part-time faculty member in the EMU Department of Chemistry possessing a Master of Science Degree in Chemistry.

Page 4, Item 6: "Training, Retraining and Instructions to Workers"

** Paragraph 2, line 2: From the information supplied in the summary in paragraph 2, it is very likely that the person spoken to on the telephone was not a graduate student, but rather a faculty member. Since the name is not given, the reader cannot be certain of this person's identity, however, the specification of "graduate student" is probably in error.

** Paragraph 2, line 3: In one case, permission was granted by Dr. Charles Anderson (a faculty member of the EMU Department of Chemistry) to Ketan Trivedi (a teaching graduate student in the EMU Department of Chemistry).

** Paragraph 2, line 5: The untrained graduate student involved was named Ketan Trivedi.

Page 6, Item 9: "Materials"

** Paragraph 2, line 8: The unauthorized teaching graduate student was named Ketan Trivedi.

It is essential that the changes and errors noted above be placed in each copy of your report wherever filed in government records. In cases where your original report was sent to other parties, I would hope you would also send those parties these same corrections.

I appreciate your attention to these matters and trust that you will acknowledge receipt of this letter. In correspondence, please use my Foundation for Instrument History & Research address above.
