All other activities (i.e., design, fabrication, assembly, testing, and modification) shall be satisfied by obtaining certifications from package suppliers that these activities were conducted in accordance with an NRC-approved QA program. It shall remain the responsibility of the licensee-user that all transportation activities meet the requirements of 10 CFR § 71.101.
- Records of instructions, procedures, drawings, and specifications as required by 10 CFR § 71.135 must be retained for three years beyond the date the activity ends, for which the QA Program was developed.
- Audits of each safety related activity shall be conducted at least once per year in accordance with preestablished written procedures or checklists by qualified personnel not having direct responsibility in the areas being audited.
