Gentlemen:

This refers to the inspection conducted by Messrs. J. L. Belanger, J. C. Howell and C. A. Schwan of this office on October 10-13 and 16-19, 1978, of activities at Dresden Nuclear Power Station, Units 1, 2 and 3, authorized by NRC Operating Licenses No. DPR-2, No. DPR-19 and No. DPR-25 and to the discussion of our findings with Mr. B. Stephenson and other members of your staff at the conclusion of the inspection.

The enclosed copy of our inspection report identifies areas examined during the inspection. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of a selective examination of procedures and representative records, observations, and interviews with personnel.

During this inspection, certain of your activities appeared to be in noncompliance with NRC requirements, as described in the enclosed Appendix A. The inspection showed that action had been taken to correct the identified noncompliance, and commitments were made during the above meeting to prevent recurrence. If your understanding of these commitments is different from that indicated in Paragraph 9 of the enclosed report, please advise this office within twenty days of your receipt of this letter.

Concerns noted during the inspection regarding the security organization are described in the enclosed Appendix B. We would appreciate your comments on the content of this Appendix within twenty days.
