This refers to the inspection conducted by Mr. D. E. Moore of this office on November 16-17, 1978, of activities authorized by NRC License No. R-122 at Tuskegee Institute Research Reactor (TIRR) and to the discussions of our findings held with Mrs. B. L. Chappell at the conclusion of the inspection.

The area examined during this inspection was your physical protection program and its implementation. Within this area, the inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel and observations by the inspector.

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
