Inspection Summary:

Inspection on September 6-7, 19, 1978 (Report Nos. 50-245/78-33; 50-336/78-29)
Area Inspected: Special security inspection to determine the details concerning the actions of a watchman employed by Interstate Security Services and assigned to the Millstone Nuclear Power Station who in a planned attempt to test the security system twice carried an unloaded concealed weapon through the metal detector at the entrance to the protected area, the first time unsuccessfully and successfully on the second try. The inspection involved 24 hours on site by two NRC regional based inspectors.

Results: No apparent items of noncompliance were identified relative to the one area inspected. The inspection findings established that the watchman used a concealed weapon to test the sensitivity of the metal detector at the access control point to the protected area but did not attempt to enter the protected area with the weapon.
