In its Memorandum and Order dated December 29, 1982, the Atomic Safety and Licensing Appeal Board (ASLAB) for the Rancho Seco plant requested the NRC Staff to address the specific assertions advanced by Robert A. Dieterich of your staff filed on December 14, 1982 regarding the reasons why the two unmodified HPI nozzles (C and D) need not undergo a radiographic inspection at each refueling outage. Mr. Dieterich's reasons were restated on Page 2 of the ASLAB Memorandum and Order.

We request that you provide the bases for the reasons you cited in your December 14, 1982 filing in order to permit the Staff to respond to the ASLAB Memorandum and Order as we discussed with your staff by telephone on January 5, 1983. Your response should also address why your program differs from the preliminary recommendations presented to the Staff by the B&W Owners Group Safe-End Task Force on December 16, 1982. You should particularly consider that the C and D thermal sleeves are of the same type and used the same installation methods as the nozzles A and B thermal sleeves that required replacement at the Rancho Seco plant.

Please provide either your response or a schedule for your response by January 10, 1983 to permit us to provide a timely reply to the ASLAB.
