The purpose of this letter is to request an administrative revision to the Certificate of Compliance for the Radioactive Material Package Model SN-1 package identification number USA/6771/b(). The current Certificate of Compliance for this package, which is revision number 3, authorized "Greater than Type A quantities of nonfissile radioactive material as solidified or dewatered waste contained in leak tight secondary containers". GPU Nuclear Corporation, who now owns this package, feels that this content is too restrictive with regards to the material that can be shipped in this package. As a result, we request that paragraph 5.(b)(1) of Certificate Number 6771, Revision 3, be changed to read as follows:

- 5. (b) Contents
 - (1) Type and Form of Material
 - (a) Greater than Type A quantities of radioactive material of nonfissile classification as process solids, either dewatered, solid or solidified, in leak tight secondary containers.
 - (b) Greater than Type A quantities of radioactive material of nonfissile classification as contaminated or irradiated solid material, such as spent reactor internals, in leak tight secondary containers.

It is our belief that the requested change will only clarify the Type and Form of material authorized for shipment within the SN-1. We also feel that this change is fully supported by the Safety Analysis Report previously submitted by Metropolitan Edison Company in April 1981 and approved by the NRC with the issuance of Revision 3. As currently written, it is unclear as to whether solid

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material could be shipped in the SN-1. A point could be made that solidified would also include solid material, but in order to be more precise, we are requesting the change. The other change is the elimination of the word 'Waste'. This is requested to eliminate any possible confusion with the term 'Nuclear Waste' as recently defined in 10CFR71.

Enclosed is our check for \$150.00 to cover the cost of this administrative change.
