ORDER

The NRC staff has filed before the Commission a motion for a stay of LBP-94-06, served March 4, 1994, in which the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board ordered the staff to (1) promptly release to Allen Mosbaugh and the Georgia Power Company "all of the easy-to-separate factual information" contained in the Office of Investigation's Report in Case No. 2-90-020R; and (2) release on April 4, 1994, the remainder of the Office of the Investigation's Report, subject to protective order.

Any answer to the NRC staff's filing from Allen Mosbaugh or the Georgia Power Company may be filed no later than March 22, 1994, in a manner to ensure receipt by the Office of the Secretary by close of business (4:15 P.M.) that same day. This answer must be no longer than 10 pages, exclusive of any supporting affidavits, and should address the factors contained in 10 C.F.R. § 2.788(e). To the extent that a party's answer relies on facts subject to dispute, appropriate references to the

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record or affidavits by knowledgeable persons should be provided.  
No further replies will be considered.


