

APPENDIX A

NOTICE OF VIOLATION

Maine Yankee Atomic Power Company
Maine Yankee Atomic Power Station

As a result of the inspection conducted on November 16, 1982, and in accordance with the NRC Enforcement Policy (10 CFR 2, Appendix C) published in the Federal Register on March 9, 1982 (47 FR 9987), the following violation was identified:

10 CFR 20.201, "Surveys", states that each licensee shall make or cause to be made a survey as necessary for the licensee to comply with the regulations in this part and are reasonable under the circumstances to evaluate the extent of radiation hazards that may be present.

Contrary to the above, on November 12, 1982, the licensee did not make a survey for a specific work area for individuals working in accordance with Radiation Work Permit (RWP 82-11-1085). Such survey was reasonable under the circumstances, to evaluate the extent of the radiation hazard that was present.

This is a Severity Level IV violation. (Supplement IV)

Pursuant to the provisions of 10 CFR 2.201, Maine Yankee Atomic Power Company is hereby required to submit to this office within 30 days of the date of the letter transmitting this Notice, a written statement or explanation in reply, including for each violation: (1) the corrective steps which have been taken and the results achieved; (2) the corrective steps which will be taken to avoid further violations; and (3) the date when full compliance will be achieved. Where good cause is shown, consideration will be given to extending the response time.

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
