Dear Congresswoman Morella:

I am responding to your December 21, 1993, letter in which you request assistance on behalf of your constituent, Mr. Diego Crespo, who is seeking a Blanket Purchase Agreement (BPA) for graphics services with the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC).

Prior to establishing his new firm, Creative Cooperative, Mr. Crespo met with our graphics staff in September 1992 and in March and April 1993 to discuss the possibility of establishing BPAs with two other firms, but he left the employ of these firms before NRC completed its evaluation of their capabilities. Consequently, ne further action was taken with respect to these inquiries. In June 1993, Mr. Crespo met with our graphics staff to describe the capabilities of Creative Cooperative. As explained in the enclosed letter to Mr. Crespo, we concluded that Creative Cooperative does not possess the inhouse capability to perform graphics services. Should Mr. Crespo develop this capability, we will be happy to schedule a site visit to inspect his facilities and discuss placing a BPA with his firm.

I trust this reply responds to your request.
