Sorry I wasn't able to give you the material you requested on the phone. To save you time, I submit the information in written form instead.

We can process TIFF files to solve your problem of storage of large files.

- TIFF files can not be stored in expanded form
- We will compress them, but you need to expand them for printing. You need to have the capability to store and print compressed files. If not, we can work these projects for you.

Why don't we try a test soon?

On the question on Imaging UNIX files, we need to know what type of files you can output (EPS, TIFF, etc.)

I can supply those very thin Textronics type prints & transparencies but only out-of-house. I wouldn't have any problem doing that, as a pass-through job or as part of a job we create.

I will call you soon to see if you have questions or need more details on the UNIX questions.
