Gentlemen:

This office has received a copy of your November 20, 1978 request which you filed with the Division of Project Management. The request is for a temporary waiver of Section III, paragraph B of the Dresden Unit No. 1 Requalification Program for Licensed Operators and Senior Operators (Limited). The request was not accompanied by an approval fee as prescribed by Section 170.22 of 10 CFR Part 170.

Requests for approvals such as that identified above should be classified in the same manner as applications for license amendments in Section 170.22. Section 170.12(c) requires that your company provide a proposed determination of the amendment (approval) class, state the basis therefor, and submit the fee with your application for the approval or amendment.

We have determined from our preliminary review that the requested action falls in fee Class II (\$1,200) because it requires review and approval of an item that is pro forma and administrative in nature and has no safety significance. You should promptly forward to this office the Class II fee of \$1,200. Fees are payable to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission by check, draft, or money order. If after the final evaluation of your request is completed it is determined that it was incorrectly classified, you will be advised.
