Gentlemen:

Thank you for your letter dated December 29, 1982, informing us of the steps you have taken to correct the first item of noncompliance which we brought to your attention in Inspection Report No. 50-295/02-20; 50-304/82-18 forwarded by our letter dated December 3, 1982. We will examine your actions relative to Item of Noncompliance (1) during a subsequent inspection.

With regard to Item of Noncompliance (2) we agree that the item was not reportable in accordance with the guidance of Regulatory Guide 1.16, "Reporting of Operating Information, Appendix A, Technical Specification."

It is our position that you are in noncompliance for failure to perform Technical Specification Surveillances at the required frequency. As a result of a January 11, 1983, telephone conversation between Mr. J. Peschel and Mr. F. Lentine of our respective staffs it is our understanding that you will respond accordingly. Please include in your response a discussion of the actions you will be taking to assure that future procedure revisions do not delete technical specification requirements.

Your cooperation with us is appreciated.
