**Correction of Error in Fitness-for-Duty Program Performance Report  
For the Period July - December 1993**

Reference: NYPA letter, W. A. Josiger to the NRC, dated March 1, 1994 (JPN-94-015/IPN-94-023), Fitness-for-Duty Program Performance Report  
For the Period July - December 1993.

Dear Sir:

During a review of the FitzPatrick Fitness-for-Duty Program Performance Report, the Authority discovered an error in the referenced letter and an apparent violation of 10 CFR 26 Subpart A Section 2.8 (e)(2). This letter corrects the error and informs the NRC of the apparent violation.

Attachment I to the referenced letter incorrectly states,

"Of the 120 blind performance samples sent to the laboratory this reporting period, all blind performance samples were correctly analyzed by the testing laboratory. "

The number of blind performance samples sent to the laboratory this reporting period is 130, not 120 as stated. All blind performance samples were correctly analyzed by the testing laboratory.

The total number of blind performance samples sent to the laboratory is less than the 10 percent per quarter required by 10 CFR 26 Subpart A Section 2.8 (e)(2). A total of 1,415 individuals were tested in this reporting period and only 130 blind performance samples (9 percent of the total) were sent the laboratory. A Deviation Event Report has been initiated and the Authority's corrective actions will be determined as a result of a critique of the event.


