Reichhold of this office on February 24, 1994 and in-office review on March 2, 1994, of activities authorized by NRC Byproduct Material License No. 48-25917-01, and to the discussion of our findings with Mr. Larry Scheider, Sr. at the conclusion of the inspection. The inspection was an examination of activities conducted under your license as they relate to radiation safety and to compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations and with the conditions of your license. The inspection consisted of a selective examination of procedures and representative records, observations, independent measurements, and interviews with personnel. During this inspection, certain of your activities were found to be in violation of NRC requirements, as specified in the enclosed Notice. A written response is required. The following four violations were also identified: (1) a radiography camera was not labeled with NDT's name, address, and telephone number, (2) pocket dosimeter readings were not recorded daily, (3) radiation warning labels on a radiography camera were almost unreadable, and (4) NDT was not authorized to transport licensed material in the package (radiography camera) under the general license granted in 10 CFR 71.12. However, we are using discretion as allowed by 10 CFR Part 2, Appendix C, Section VII.B in the NRC Enforcement Policy and are not including these items in the Notice of Violation because you committed to take appropriate corrective actions, the items are categorized as Severity level V violations, and the remaining criteria in the aforementioned Enforcement Policy are satisfied. In accordance with 10 CFR 2.790 of the Commission's regulations, a copy of this letter, the enclosure, and your response to this letter will be placed in the NRC Public Document Room.
