
SUBJECT: FITNESS FOR DUTY CONCERNS AT ZION STATION

If necessary, such information shall be contained in a separate attachment which will be withheld from public disclosure.

The enclosure to this letter is considered Exempt from Public Disclosure in accordance with Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations, Part 2.790. However, a copy of this letter, excluding the enclosure, will be placed in the NRC Public Document Room.
