Specifically, please provide information regarding:


1. The architecture, configuration and components offered by Government Telecommunications, Inc..
2. Did the winning bid of \$269,359 include any costs associated with the provision of trunking to the LEC (DID/DOD, FEX) in order to obtain network access? If not, did the NRC attribute a cost to the provision of such service in its evaluation process?
3. Did the winning bid of \$269,359 include any costs associated with the provision of interbuilding cabling between the two NRC Maria Lane buildings? If not, what cost did the NRC attribute to this requirement in its evaluation process?
4. Please provide the results of the NRC's final evaluation comparisons between Government Telecommunications, Inc. and the other losing bidders, including both technical and cost proposal comparisons.
