The topic discussed was Palmetto Alliance's request for a three-week extension of time to file the following three responses, then due on January 14, 1983:

1. Palmetto Alliance motion to compel re: Staff responses to interrogatories and motion for a protective order, filed December 15, 1982.
2. Palmetto Alliance grounds for relief against Applicants' objections and responses of September 22 and October 19, 1982.


3. Palmetto Alliance motion to compel in response to Applicants' responses to interrogatories and motion for a protective order, filed December 31, 1982.

Counsel for both Applicants and Staff opposed a three-week extension, but indicated that they would have no objection to an extension of ten days to two weeks. On the basis of the discussion and in the context of our Memorandum and Order of January 11, 1983 denying a lengthy extension request, the Board grants Palmetto Alliance a two-week extension of time in which to serve the above filings, until Friday, January 28, 1983.

As a consequence of this extension, the following deadlines, set forth on page 17 of the Board's December 22, 1982 Memorandum and Order, are also extended by two weeks:

1. The January 25, 1983 date for the Board to rule on Palmetto Alliance's grounds for relief.
2. The February 11, 1983 deadline for Applicants to serve any required supplemental answers.
3. The February 21, 1982 deadline for Palmetto to serve a second set of follow-up interrogatories on Applicants.
