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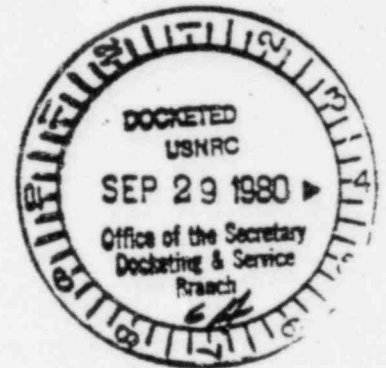

Gentlemen:

As a citizen concerned about nuclear power, I have recently become aware of a NRC staff study dated 26 June 1980, SECY80-107, "Proposed Interim Hydrogen Control Requirements for Small Containment". Citing the inconsistencies contained therein, I request that the Commission reopen licensing hearings on the McGuire Nuclear Station. The possible problems concerning inadequate containment and the failure of the hydrogen recombining system have not been made fully aware to the public, and the reopening of licensing hearings would be the proper vehicle for adequate public comment. I feel confident your decision to reopen licensing hearings would be in the best public interest, and I await your response on this crucial matter.
