Dear Mr. Ruch:

This letter is to confirm the telephone conversation between Messrs. Moore and Polley of your office and Barclay of Harshaw Chemical Company by which our proposal of March 28, 1957 is to be modified.

We now propose to acquire title to all items of equipment and scrap, 'as is', 'where is', contaminated or otherwise, in custody of The Harshaw Chemical Company as of this date, exclusive of that equipment 'ear-marked' for transfer to the Federal Penitentiary at Terra Haute, Indiana. The Harshaw Chemical Company will assume responsibility and cost for decontamination of the equipment.

In consideration of the above proposal we will increase the Harshaw Allowance from \$10,000.00 as indicated in our letter of March 28, 1957 to \$16,095.00, which will reduce the net cost to the Atomic Energy Commission to \$40,000.00.

This will allow the Atomic Energy Commission to terminate its contractual obligation to The Harshaw Chemical Company on April 30, 1957, with exception of the provision for building decontamination.

Your favorable consideration of this proposal will be appreciated.
