Modification No. 83 Supplemental Agreement to Contract No. W-7405-Eng-276 SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT THIS SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT, entered into the 21 day of Februar 1956, effective as of January 1, 1956, by and between the UNITED STATES O AMERICA (hereinafter referred to as the "Government"), represented herein by the UNITED STATES ATOMIC ENERGY COMMISSION (hereinafter referred to as the "Commission"), and the HARSHAW CHEMICAL COMPANY (hereinafter referred

to as the "Contractor"), a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Ohio, with its principal office in Cleveland, Ohio;

WITNESSETH THAT:

WHEREAS, the Government and the Contractor entered into Contract No. W-7405-Eng-276, dated May 27, 1944, providing for the design, equipping and operation of a plant by the Contractor; and

WHEREAS, the said contract has been amended heretofore by Modifications Nos. 1 - 82: and

WHEREAS, Article II-A (Modification No. 81) of the contract, which provides for an extension, on the terms and for the compensation therein more particularly described, of the period during which the Contractor will maintain Plant C of the Harvard-Denison Plant in standby condition, contemplates that at some time during such extended term the Contractor might desire to use some unoccupied portion of said Plant C for its own purposes and further, that any such proposed use would be permitted where not prejudicial to the Commission's interest in maintaining the plant in standby condition; and

WHEREAS, the afgrementioned Article II-A provides that in consideration of any such use of space by the Contractor, payments to the Contractor under the contract will be appropriately abated, and the contract amended to reflect such abatement; and

WHEREAS, the parties are now desirous of further amending the contract so as to authorize the Contractor to use for its own purposes a certain additional portion of the said Plant C, and to effect a mutually agreeable reduction in the aforementioned payments to the Contractor; and

WHEREAS, this Supplemental Agreement is authorized to and executed under the Atomic Energy Act of 1954 in the interest of the common defense and security;

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NOW, THEREFORE, said Contract No. W-7405-Eng-276 is modified in the following respect, but in no other:

Effective January 1, 1956, the Contractor shall have the right to use for its own purposes that portion of Plant C of the Contractor's Harvard-Denison Plant delineated by red crosshatching on the Contractor's Drawing No. 1178-10, which is attached to this Modification No. 83 and made a part of the contract, comprising 12,580 square feet of building space and 12,000 square feet of yard space, resulting in an increase in the space permitted to be used by the Contractor of 6.025 square feet of building space and 5,440 square feet of yard space. In consideration of said increase, it is agreed that, pursuant to Paragraph 4 of Article II-A (Modification No. 81), the Government shall be entitled to a further abatement of the monthly payments provided to be made to the Contractor under Paragraph 1. g. of the said Article II-A in the lump sum amount of \$1,510.25 per month so long as such payments shall continue. resulting in payments under the said Paragraph 1. g. at the new rate of \$11,967.45 per month. It is further agreed that the Commission's obligations with respect to restoration of the Contractor's premises, said obligations being set forth in Paragraph 1. f. of Article II-A, shall not extend to that part of the said premises to be used by the Contractor in accordance with the foregoing understanding.



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
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
