This is in response to your December 3, 1982 request for comments on the final draft Remodial Action Concept Paper (RACP) for the Shiprock inactive uranium mill tailings site. The revised RACP appears to adequately address those NRC staff comments previously transmitted to the Project Office by letter dated September 20, 1982. However, several additional revisions, most of which relate to the recent issuance of the final EPA Standards, are considered appropriate. It is recommended that all references to the proposed and interim EPA Standards be deleted and replaced with references to and discussion of the final EPA Standards 4, 5, 6, 8 and 11 of the RACP.

In addition, given that as stated on pg. 1 of the RACP the Cooperative Agreement between DOE and the Navajo Nation has not yet been formalized, it is recommended that the references to this agreement on pg. 16 be cast in terms of "provisions of the draft cooperative agreement".

Finally, it is our understa ding that in view of recent action it would be appropriate to revise the statement in Section 9.5 (pg.17) to indicate that DOE has recently selected Morrison-Knudsen as the remedial action contractor (RAC) to provide architect-engineer and construction management services.
