SUBJECT: CONSOLIDATION OF LICENSES FOR SWEDEN

XSNM-1997

On November 9, 1982, Edlow International Company asked that all currently valid export licenses held by that firm for Sweden be consolidated into one license valid until January 1, 1990. The current licenses cover ten ASEA-ATOM power facilities for a total of 517,513.816 kilograms of uranium enriched to a maximum of 4.05% U-235.

This consolidation will simplify the licensee's procedures and records. It does not increase the quantity of material already authorized for export for the ten facilities and upon issuance of the consolidated license those licenses which it replaces will be cancelled with the agreement of Edlow International.

This consolidated license has been reviewed and approved by ELD.
