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SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT

THIS SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT, entered into the 19th day of October, 1950, by and between THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA (hereinafter referred to as the "Government") and THE HARSHAW CHEMICAL COMPANY (hereinafter referred to as the "Contractor");

WITNESSETH, THAT:

WHEREAS, on the 27th day of May, 1944, effective as of the 5th day of January, 1944, the Government and the Contractor entered into Contract No. N-7405-eng-276 for the design, equipping and operation of a plant; and

WHEREAS, said contract has heretofore been amended from time to time; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the terms of said contract, the Contractor has given notice of tender for acceptance regarding certain production lots; and

WHEREAS, said lots are usable for the purpose for which Chemical PH-30 is intended but do not meet specification requirements; and

WHEREAS, it is in the interest of the Government to accept the Contractor's work with respect to said production lots at reduced per pound compensation; and

WHEREAS, such acceptance is provided for in paragraph 5 of Article V of said contract as amended by Amendment No. 52 thereto; and

WHEREAS, in connection with such acceptance, the pertinent Secret Letter (which is dated as of June 9th, 1950) is being simultaneously amended; and

WHEREAS, this Supplemental Agreement is authorized by law, including the Atomic Energy Act of 1946 and Executive Order No. 9816 dated December 31, 1946, and is in the interest of the common defense and security;

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties hereto do mutually agree as follows with respect to said Contract No. W-7405-eng-276, as heretofore amended concerning the contract period subsequent to June 30th, 1950:

- 2. The reduced per pound compensation to be paid, and payable, by the Government under said contract with respect to said production lots is \$0.2555 per pound of product.
- 3. The Government furnishes, and the Contractor accepts, the naterial embraced in said production lots as feed materials under said contract with like force and effect as though same constitutes Chemical
- 4. In view of the foregoing, the quantity of Chemical PH-30 to be produced under said contract during the period commencing on July 1st, 1950, and ending on September 30th, 1950, shall be as set forth in Amendment No. 4 to the Secret Letter mentioned in paragraph 2 of contract Article I.
