The enclosed probabilistic seismic hazard estimates for St. Lucie and Turkey Point sites are preliminary values developed by LLNL in December 1992. The ground motion inputs are still under development and final hazard estimates will ultimately become available in NUREG form. Since these estimates are preliminary and subject to change in the near future, anyone would be ill advised to use them in making judgements about a site or for decisions to expend resources.
