> SUBJECT: Arkansas Nuclear One - Unit 2 Docket No. 50-368 License No. NPF-6 Proposed Diesel Generator Load Block Timing Technical Specification Change

Gentlemen:

Attached is a Technical Specification change request regarding Surveillance Requirement 4.8.1.1.2.c.2. The proposed change is to clarify the interpretation of the allowable tolerance in the interval between successive loads when loading the Diesel Generator. This change obviates the need for the change request submitted on August 12, 1980, (2CANØ88ØØ8) and is submitted to supersede the previous request.

Your letter of January 19, 1982, (2CNAØ182Ø3) suggested several options to resolve a difference in interpretation between NRC and AP&L regarding Surveillance Requirement 4.8.1.1.2.c.2. The second option in your letter was to provide additional information supporting our interpretation that the 10 percent-of-interval tolerence applies to the total elapsed time for each load rather than the interval between successive loads. To support this option our supplier, Colt Industries, provided a study which examined the consequences of coincident application of successive loads when such was possible. The Colt study demonstrated our equipment would meet the guidance of Regulatory Guide 1.9 under conditions of coincident loading and thus eliminate any concern associated with loading interval overlap. This study is our basis for the proposed change; a copy is enclosed.
