In response to your letter of April 4, 1980, transmitting IE Bulletin 80-13, Carolina Power and Light Company submits the following information:

The Brunswick Steam Electric Plant Unit No. 1 core spray spargers and in-vessel piping have been visually inspected using Periodic Test 90.1, and no indication of cracking was noted. This inspection was completed on January 15, 1983.

As requested in the bulletin, each unit will be inspected during all future refueling outages until further notice with a follow-up report to be issued within thirty (30) days of the completion of the test.
