Dear Mr. Lee:

It has come to our attention that, due to the delegation of licensing functions to Region IV for the Fort St. Vrain Nuclear Station, some confusion exists related to various reporting requirements. In an effort to resolve any confusion, a meeting was held on January 17, 1983 between members of my staff and the staffs of the Division of Safeguards, Office of Nuclear Material Safety and Safeguards, and the Division of Security, Office of Administration. Agreement was reached at that meeting that your facility will be treated as all other facilities with the exception that normal communications will be made to and from Region IV, vice the Office of Nuclear Reactor Regulation, in accordance with the change to 10 CFR 50.4.

It should be noted that the present Regulations (e.g. 10 CFR Parts 10, 11, 25 and 95) require reporting to the Division of Security; you should continue your present reporting requirements accordingly. Therefore, unless otherwise specified in the regulations, all communications and reports should be submitted to Region IV.

I hope that this resolves the confusion you may have because of the unique features of your facility. If you have any questions on this matter, please contact your NRC Project Manager.
