Gentlemen/Ms,

In response to my request, the staff sent a copy of the Generic Issues Tracking System (GITS), APTS report, along with a copy of NUREG-0606. While I appreciate the staff's effort in this regard, unfortunately, we seem to be in slight disagreement as to what type of information is being specifically sought.

In my request I clearly defined the term "design generic issues" as design deficiencies. What the staff sent was essentially updated versions of NUREG-0410 and NUREG-0737.

Perhaps, our lack of communication on this matter stems from a lack of clarity in my request and, if so, my apologies for any inconvenience to staff. However, to avoid any further misinterpretations, the following should serve as an illustration as to the type of information specifically being requested:

DESIGN DEFICIENCY

MAJOR INTERIM ACTION

Air system problems

Automatic air header dump on low air pressure (and in the interim, as a backup, a manual SCRAM on low air pressure alarm is required)

Complex vent piping

provide or verify positive, operable vent


