SUBJECT: REPORT NO. 50-389/82-60

This refers to the routine safety inspection conducted by Mr. W. P. Kleinsorge of this office on November 16-19, 1982, of activities authorized by NRC Construction Permit No. CPPR-144 for the St. Lucie facility. Our preliminary findings were discussed with Mr. B. J. Escue, Site Manager, at the conclusion of the inspection.

Areas examined during the inspection and our findings are discussed in the enclosed inspection report. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observations by the inspector.

During the inspection, it was found that certain activities under your license appear to violate NRC requirements. This violation which was upgraded from a previous unresolved item, and references to pertinent requirements are listed in the Notice of Violation enclosed herewith as Appendix A. Since this item has been reported in accordance with 10 CFR 50.55(e), corrective actions will be reviewed; therefore a reply is not requested.

We have examined actions you have taken with regard to previously identified enforcement matters and unresolved icems. The status of these items is discussed in the enclosed report.

Two new unresolved items are identified in the enclosed inspection report. These items will be examined during subsequent inspections.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.790(a), a copy of this letter and the enclosures will be placed in the NRC's Public Document Room unless you notify this office, by telephone, within ten days of the date of this letter and submit written application to withhold information contained therein within thirty days of the date of this letter. Such application must be consistent with the requirements of 2.790(b)(1).
