This is in response to your letter dated June 25, 1982, in which you requested, pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act, copies of Nuclear Regulatory Commission records concerring the four categories of information described in your request which relate to the use of radioactive materials as radiological weapons.

We have not located any documents in the files of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission that are subject to any of the four categories described in your letter.

The United States nuclear materials production program and the military applications program, as they were administered by the U.S. Atomic Energy Commission prior to January 19, 1975, were transferred to the Energy Research and Development Administration (ERDA) on that date. Subsequently, the ERDA organization became a part of the present Department of Energy.
